## The Stoke-on-Trent

**Foodbank** helps individuals and families in crisis through the provision of emergency food supplies.

Local care professionals in the Stoke-on-Trent area refer people, with a food voucher, to one of 13

### **Stoke-on-Trent Foodbank distribution centres**

where they are given their food supplies, a cup of coffee and help in finding other professionals who can help them out of their crisis.

(In special cases we can deliver Emergency Food Boxes directly, or give boxes to local care-workers to distribute)
